Electric Forest is back in our area and we were offered the opportunity to have a small alumni marching band play for this event! This event also helps fund the band program and others in our Oceana County through this performance.

We can only take a small amount of players for this event. We start with seniors and alumni and then can reach out to younger classmen to fill instrumentation in. If you are receiving this letter, you are invited to perform with us.

Rehearsals are June 20th 6:00-8:00pm and June 21st 5-7pm at Shelby Middle School with performance on Saturday the 22nd at Electric Forest.

- 3:00pm - Band arrives - Drop off behind sherwood. Temporary parking in Lot C for their school bus behind carousel for pick up.
- 3:20pm - Band enters from sherwood stage right and walks to the east entrance of Forest, will stage near "Elle" the elephant for a performance
- 3:30 - Forest Parade 2-3 stagings of band in forest based on time
- Band marches East on North Crossbow
- south on Loxley Lane (first performance, 2-3 songs, near east side of observatory)
- west on Friar Tuck's Turn
- north on Wally Wojack Way (second performance, 2-3 songs, under sherwood sign)
- 4:00pm - Band exits forest, does not stop at bell tower but continues to march
- 4:05pm - Band stages in front of dream emporium and Carousel for a 2-3 song performance
- 4:20pm - Band exits Stage right of carousel, outside of tent, via porto gate
- 4:30pm - Bus exits property

The performance is rather quick and involves the marching band parking and playing multiple times on the back entrance of the forest where people love to listen. By signing below you are agreeing to the rehearsals and performance. We ask that a parent/guardian signs this to approve their child attending this performance. Students below the age of 18 are not able to attend without approval of a guardian.
